In 2011, the Presbyterian Church (USA) adopted a new form of government, perhaps ironically known as "n-FOG." For some, it felt quite foggy! But the point was to clear up some of our practices which were "one size fits all," for churches of 20 or 2,000. This new form of government frees up sessions to adopt practices that work in that particular congregation.

Children have long been allowed to take communion in Presbyterian churches, and now even those people who have not yet been baptized are welcome at the Table. We try to keep communion as open and unfenced as we possibly can. But there was still the issue of who serves.

It used to be that only elders and deacons could serve, whether presently on a board or at rest. That occasionally created an issue on Sunday morning as someone scooted around looking for a body to serve. No more. Now Session may approve anyone they wish to serve.

Anyone! I'm delighted that we now have a policy that anyone 4th grade and up may serve communion! Of course, I'm not going to grab someone who's never served at the Table on Sunday morning. Later this summer, I'm going to hold a Saturday class for anyone who would like to take part. We'll make communion bread for the following day, and we'll learn all the particulars of how to serve. We'll partake that day, so everyone has a chance to practice what it feels like, and to get comfortable with the words. This is the bread of heaven. This is the cup of salvation. This is my body. This is my blood.

Wouldn't it be wonderful to see a group of kids serving communion on a Sunday morning? I continue to look for opportunities for our kids to be involved—as liturgists, ushers, water bearers, acolytes, dramatists, dancers... If I'm missing something, please let me know! And if you know a young person who would like to participate, also let me know. My hope is an "opener" communion table where all are welcome—as guests and hosts.

May you find rich blessings in the season of Easter, and may your spiritual life be filled with joy—even when the days feel hard. May you provide healing to one in need, or accept the hand of grace when offered to you. Meanwhile, I'll see you in church!
